

2024 Volunteer Program

All successful non-profit organizations rely on the work of volunteers. The AMFA is no different, as we depend on volunteers to run & help support our association both on and off the field. We are looking to our AMFA families to join us as we continue to create a positive environment for our kids to experience the joy of sport.

The Association is made up of many valuable contributors who generously give their time to improve the game. We have a variety of different roles that need to be filled every season, including but not limited to support at our Opening Day festivities, managing our concession stands, helping with the field set up at tournaments, and year-round engagement opportunities as an executive.

Currently, we have two key initiatives that will require association-wide team participation.

- **1. The Learn to Play Program**: The AMFA is on track to register over 200 U7 and U9 kids this season. The success of our U7 & U9 program depends largely on the volunteers who help facilitate it. We are asking for teams to sign up to help out at our Saturday morning sessions.
- **2. Challenger Baseball:** We are excited to partner with Challenger Baseball for the 2024 season. This is a wonderful program that provides an opportunity for children with cognitive or physical disabilities to enjoy the full benefits of participation in baseball at a level structured to their abilities. There are 8 weeks of Challenger sessions and we would like to provide AMFA representation and support each week.

Sign-up forms for both of the above opportunities will be circulated to coaches and managers in the Spring.

We also be hosting the annual U11 Spirit of the Game tournament in May, Celebration of Softball tournament in June, and Opening Day on April 6 in addition to the 2 initiatives above, so there are lots of opportunities for parents, supporters, and players to get involved. The success of these events, and others like photo day and the Winter Jubilee will be largely dependent on the contributions of the broader community.

We aim to reward individuals and teams who make positive contributions to the AMFA. Each month, we will collect nominations for individual volunteers of the month, and at the end of the season, one Outlaws team and one House team will be awarded a budget for a team end-up party based on their contributions.
